The *Collected Critical Writings* gathers more than forty years of Hill's published criticism in a revised final form and also adds much new work. It will serve as the canonical volume of criticism by Hill, the pre-eminent poet-critic whom A. N. Wilson has called probably the best writer alive in verse or in prose. In his criticism Hill ranges widely, investigating both poets including Jonson, Dryden, Hopkins, Whitman, Eliot, and Yeats and prose writers such as Tyndale, Clarendon, Hobbes, Burton, Emerson, and F. H. Bradley. He is also steeped in the historical context, political, poetic, and religious of the writers he studies.
