The macho model of presidential leadership is developed well and supported by both primary and secondary research. The text is well documented and every assumption is illustrated by several specific examples. The humanistic study is written from an audience perspective providing a socio-psychological orientation of how the public interprets the office. The president of the United States may be considered the quintessential symbol of the country and as such a reflection of society's dominant values. His actions and decisions are influenced by a number of factors including the prevailing environment, bureaucratic policies, and the incumbent's personality. His hypothesis is that a president's success depends on the ability to align actions with a society that places a premium on machismo.
