

The 7 Dimensions of Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA)

All behavioural interventions include the seven dimensions of ABA, which are:

1. Applied

This means that the behaviours selected for change must be socially significant to the client. The behaviour change must benefit the client by improving their quality of life, by increasing their independence, and/or by increasing their integration in society.



2. Behavioural

The behaviours selected for change (i.e., target behaviours) must be observable and measurable. Behaviour is anything a person can do or say.



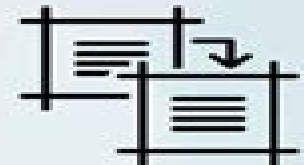
3. Analytic

A behavioural intervention is determined to be successful once it has demonstrated reliable control over the target behaviour. This is achieved by ensuring that the behavioural intervention is what is responsible for the behaviour change, and not some confounding variable.



4. Technological

The intervention procedures must be written in enough detail for anyone to be able to replicate it & get the same results.



5. Conceptual Systems

The interventions must use ABA terms and principles derived from evidence-based literature.



6. Effective

A behavioural intervention is effective when the behaviour change it produces is large enough to be considered of practical value. Social validity is a great measure of effectiveness that would involve examining:

- The social significance of the target behaviour selected
- The social appropriateness of the procedures - i.e., reinforcement or punishment procedure, ethicality, etc.
- The social importance of the effects - i.e., is the client & other consumers satisfied with the behaviour change that occurred? Did it lead to social integration and/or increased independence and quality of life for the client?



7. Generality

The behavioural intervention must produce a durable change in behaviour that lasts across settings, people, and behaviours.
