## LEAST SQUARES REGRESSION

Goal: Minimize the sum of the squares of the residuals (errors).

Residual  $r_i = y_i - \hat{y}_i$

$S_y = \sum_{i=1}^n y_i$ ,  $S_x = \sum_{i=1}^n x_i$ ,  $S_{xy} = \sum_{i=1}^n x_i y_i$

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$a_0 = \frac{S_y}{n}$ ,  $a_1 = \frac{S_{xy} - \frac{S_y S_x}{n}}{S_x - \frac{S_x^2}{n}}$

POLYNOMIAL QUADRATIC REGRESSION:

$S_y = \sum_{i=1}^n (y_i - a_0 - a_1 x_i - a_2 x_i^2)^2$

$\frac{\partial S_y}{\partial a_0} = -2(\sum y_i - \sum a_0 - a_1 \sum x_i - a_2 \sum x_i^2) = 0$

$\frac{\partial S_y}{\partial a_1} = -2(\sum x_i y_i - \sum a_0 \sum x_i - a_1 \sum x_i^2 - a_2 \sum x_i^3) = 0$

$\frac{\partial S_y}{\partial a_2} = -2(\sum x_i^2 y_i - \sum a_0 \sum x_i^2 - a_1 \sum x_i^3 - a_2 \sum x_i^4) = 0$
