

properties of statistics derived from the estimation results For the latter the detection of DIF items is usually based on statistical methods for categorical data with the total test score as a matching criterion Item Response Theory IRT techniques provide a powerful means of testing items for bias using what is known as differential item functioning DIF analysis In contrast Classical Test Theory CTT based methods of assessing bias are fundamentally limited especially approaches that base their assessment of bias on the presence of group mean differences in total tests scores across demographic groups This book provides different studies to detect a gender related DIF in mathematics

Brussow,2018 **Unexpected Direction of Differential Item Functioning** Sangwook Park,2011 ABSTRACT Many studies have been conducted to evaluate the performance of DIF detection methods when two groups have different ability distributions Such studies typically have demonstrated factors that are associated with inflation of Type I error rates in DIF detection such as mean ability differences However no study has examined how the direction of DIF is affected by the factors that inflate the Type I error rate Therefore this study investigated the possibility that the direction of DIF is systematically detected in an unexpected way which may result in unexpected detection of DIF advantaging lower ability groups on difficult items An extensive simulation was conducted to evaluate whether DIF in unexpected directions was observed systematically under the logistic regression approach to DIF detection Four factors were considered in this study 1 means of ability distributions 2 standard deviations of ability distributions 3 sample sizes and 4 the magnitude of the pseudo guessing parameters Three levels were considered for the ability means and two levels were considered for the ability standard deviations Three levels were examined for sample sizes and guessing parameters As a result 54 3 x 2 x 3 x 3 simulation conditions were considered In addition items were grouped into five groups depending on their difficulties very easy easy moderate difficult and very difficult The effects of the four simulation factors were evaluated for each one of the five item difficulty groups For each condition 500 replications were conducted DIF error rates bias SE RMSE the direction of DIF and distributions of the biases were examined to evaluate the effects of the four simulation factors The results revealed that the mean of the ability distribution and the magnitude of the pseudo guessing parameters indeed contributed dramatically to inflation of DIF error rates especially for very easy and very difficult items Moreover the directions of DIF were all negative for very easy items but all positive for very difficult items Finally limitations and practical implications were discussed The Effect of the Probability of Correct Response on the Variability of Measures of Differential Item Functioning Rebecca Zwick,1994 **Impact of Differential Item Functioning on Statistical**

Conclusions ,2005 Differential item functioning DIF sometimes called item bias has been widely studied in educational and psychological measurement however to date research has focused on the definitions of and the methods for detecting DIF It is well accepted that the presence of DIF may degrade the validity of a test There is relatively little known however about the impact of DIF on later statistical decisions when one uses the observed test scores in data analyses and corresponding statistical hypothesis tests This dissertation investigated the impact of DIF on later statistical decisions based on the observed total test or scale score Very little is known in the literature about the impact of DIF on the Type I error rate and effect size of for instance the independent samples t test on the observed total test scores Five studies were conducted studies one to three investigated the impact of unidirectional DIF i e DIF amplification on the Type I error rate and effect size of the independent samples t test studies four and five investigated the DIF cancellation effects on the Type I error rate and effect size of the independent samples t test The Type I error rate and effect size were defined in terms of latent population means rather than observed sample means The results showed that the amplification and cancellation effects among uniform DIF items did transfer to the test level Both the Type I error rate and effect size were inflated The degree of inflation depends on the number of DIF items magnitude of DIF sample sizes and interactions among these factors These findings highlight the importance of screening DIF before conducting any further statistical analysis It offers advice to practicing researchers about when and how much the presence of DIF will affect their statistical conclusions based on the total observed test scores

Hanson,1997 **The Effect of Differential Item Functioning on Population Invariance of Item Response Theory True Score Equating** Anne C Huggins,2012 Population invariance in equating exists when the relationship between two scales is the same for two or more subpopulations of examinees and hence the function used to equate the scales is not dependent on subpopulations A lack of equating invariance i e equating dependence leads to a situation whereby examinees having the same score on one scale but belonging to different subpopulations have different expected test scores on the corresponding equated scale This situation results in an expected advantage for one or more subpopulations of examinees and hence is a concern for fairness in assessment and disaggregated accountability Little is known about the causes of equating dependence and the purpose of this study is to locate a source of this problem It is hypothesized that differential item functioning manifested in the anchor items of an assessment will have an effect on population invariance of equating Findings show that when differential item functioning varies across forms in a differential manner across subpopulations population invariance of equating can be compromised Under these conditions an increase in equating dependence is associated with increases in magnitudes of the differential item functioning and to a lesser degree increases in the frequency of anchor items with differential item functioning These effects can be problematic in conditions of both unidirectional and bidirectional differential item functioning and can pose problems for subpopulations

that have equal or different mean ability levels

Questions Pamela Jane Brown, 1996 The application of Differential Item Functioning DIF analysis to noncognitive areas such as psychological and attitudinal measurement is a natural extension of the current research and is the focus of this study This study uses DIF analyses to examine differential item functioning of Likert response items formatted from survey instruments Data for this study were drawn from the responses of 22 651 parents of eighth grade students on 26 questions from the National Educational Longitudinal Survey of 1988 National Center for Education Statistics 1990 A differential item functioning analysis of these 26 questions was conducted to determine if different groups of parents interpreted the survey questions differently To detect DIF in this survey logit models were utilized Total score for each substantive area was employed as the conditioning variable The study revealed that DIF analyses can be conducted with noncognitive instruments using multiple factors simultaneously to yield important information about the questions In this survey several of the questions were functioning differently for different groups of parents based on their race or whether their child attended a city school For a few questions the interaction term between race and urbanicity was significant in the model thus providing more insight into understanding DIF The focus of this study was to exemplify three points a that instruments other than cognitive tests can exhibit DIF b that interaction terms are important to include when testing models and c that studying groups defined on characteristics not commonly used in current DIF studies can provide better insight into DIF Survey instruments are a commonly used tool in evaluations and other studies to gather information regarding opinions and attitudes from large groups of people Because the responses from surveys are often reported in an aggregate form it is often the case that the survey questions are being summarized uniformly for the entire sample An assumption is made in most cases that the survey questions are being interpreted consistently across the population of respondents One method of verifying this assumption is to utilize differential item functioning analysis This study demonstrates the utility of DIF for this purpose
