Castles were the fortified mansions of kings, noble men and feudal lords. They were located in strategic places to control possible attacks, and in the inside they had everything necessary to resist in case the castle was besieged. Peasants of the feudal lands property of the lord could get shelter in them in case of an attack.

**CISTERN**  
It collected the water from the pipes that ran throughout the castle.

**BREAD OVEN**  
It was located inside the production where the bread supply in case of siege.

**KNIGHTS' CHAMBER**  
The knights and the lord's chambers were located in it, in the lower part they kept the richness of the lord.

## HUNTING

Within the castle grounds, hunting, which was practiced in the woods surrounding the castle. They were also used for military, where in the hunting of birds using trained hawks.

**LATRINES**  
They were common, although they were not their own. The residual waters went to the moat.

**THICK WALL**  
It is the last raised system and received distinguished visitors.

The lower part of the wall contained the rooms of the knights. During the sieges the knights were divided into two and they employed a tactic, should more difficult conditions in which the commanders found their walls, hunting weapons.

## JESTERS

Their mission was entertaining the lords of the castle. They used to wear suits of vivid colors.

## CELEBRATIONS

During peace times, nobility and high-ranking great banquets that lasted several days. Banquets were made more exquisite with tournaments, jousts and literary recitations, in which poems and orations participated.

**MOAT**  
Many castles were surrounded by a moat filled with water to avoid assaults. In order, a drawbridge was used.

**CRENS**  
The towers and battlements of the wall had holes to be able to shoot at the enemy.

**SECRET PASSAGES**  
Attendants were locked in them. They were located underground or on the highest part of a tower.
