- German biologist- **Ernst Haeckel** first coined the word ecology in 1866; ecology came from a Greek word *oikos* and *logos*oikos which means house while *logos* means the study of.
- **Ecologist** is a person who studies the association or interaction between organisms with their physical environment.
- The distribution and abundance of organisms on Earth is shaped by both **biotic**, living-organism-related, and **abiotic**, nonliving or physical, factors.
