


1 Setting up the board


BOARD ORIENTATION

Before placing the pieces, it's important to start with the proper orientation of the board. No matter which side of the board you're on, the bottom right square should be white.




PLACING THE PIECES

1. **Pawns** should fill the second ranks (rows) of each side of your board.



2. **Rooks** are placed in the corners, just like towers on a real castle.



3. Moving one file (column) inward, **Knights** (Horses) go next to the rooks.



4. **Bishops** go between the horses and your royalty, the King and Queen.



5. The **Queen** goes on her own colored square, white on light and black on dark.



6. The **King** goes on the last available square. It should be the opposite of his color.
