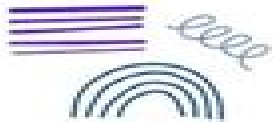


ELEMENTS OF GRAPHIC DESIGN

A flat enclosed area with two dimensions: length and width. Shapes can be geometric or organic.



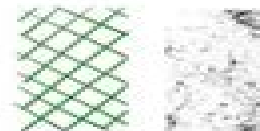
Form

An enclosed area with three dimensions: depth, length, and width.



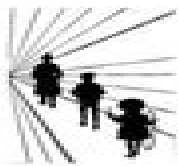
TEXTURE
